*At Innsbruck 1964 Debbi Wilkes and Guy Revell initially won the bronze medal but were upgraded to silver in 1966 when it was revealed that the original second place finishers from West Germany had signed a professional contract prior to the Games, which would have made them ineligible. In 1987 the silver medals were returned to the Germans, however Wilkes and Revell remain as co-silver medallists and the Americans who had been upgraded from fourth place remain as bronze medallists.

**This total does not include the gold medal won at the Antwerp 1920 Olympic Games, at which ice hockey was an official event prior to the first Olympic Winter Games in 1924.
