



**TEAM CANADA 50/50  
OFFICIAL RULES OF PLAY  
MANITOBA RAFFLE**

**Updated July 21, 2021**

1. The winning number will be selected using a Random Number Generation (RNG) system.
2. The Jackpot for each 5050 Draw shall be the total proceeds from Raffle tickets sold during the time period for that 5050 Draw. The Winner for each 5050 Draw will receive a cash prize (the “5050 Prize”) equal to fifty percent (50%) of the final Jackpot amount for the particular 5050 Draw. The other fifty percent (50%) of the Jackpot will be retained by the COF, and the funds will be used by COF in its sole and absolute discretion, to support various charitable groups and causes throughout Manitoba and as otherwise approved by the Liquor, Gaming and Cannabis Authority of Manitoba (“LGCA”).
3. The Jackpot draw dates on August 1, 2021 (ticket sales close July 31, 2021) and August 9, 2021 (tickets close on August 8, 2021) will have a guaranteed take home prize of \$3,000 per draw.
4. The winner of the Early Bird Prize for each draw period will still be eligible for the 5050 Prize Draw for that draw period.
5. The Raffle is open only to persons who are located in the Province of Manitoba at the time of entry and who are eighteen (18) years of age or older.
6. The following individuals are ineligible to win a prize:
  - a. Any person directly involved in or responsible for selecting the Winning Number;
  - b. Employees, interns and Board of Directors of the Canadian Olympic Foundation (COF);
  - c. Employees, interns and Board of Directors of the Canadian Olympic Committee
  - d. Members of the same household, (whether or not related) of any of the above (a-c).
7. Each prize claimant must provide COF with all information required by COF and/or provincial gaming regulations to demonstrate they are the Winner and claim the Prize, which may include providing government issued identification. In order to receive the Prize, the Prize claimant will also be required to sign a Declaration and Release (“Release”) which must be executed and returned to COF no later than five (5) business days after his/her receipt of the Release.
8. The prize for the Early Bird Draw and the 5050 Draw must be claimed by the winner, within sixty (60) days of the applicable draw, by contacting the 50/50 office at the email or telephone number indicated below. Any unclaimed prizes will be forfeited by the Winner and will be donated by COF to a charity/non-profit organization with the approval of the LGCA or as otherwise directed by the LGCA.



9. All Prizes will be sent to the Winners via cheque or electronic funds transfer (as determined by COF) within thirty (30) days of COF confirming the prize claimant as the Winner. For security and safety reasons, no cash payments will be made to the Winners.
10. Raffle Tickets are non-transferable.
11. For groups purchasing a Raffle Ticket together, groups must select one individual to handle the purchase; provided, however, that in the event of a dispute over ownership of the Winning Number, the individual listed in the Application Form for the Winning Number, will be presumed to be the Winner. COF shall have no responsibility to any other person who claims any interest or right to receive all or any part of the prize associated with a Winning Number.
12. All personal information, such as name and contact information, required in the Application Form, to enter a Draw or purchase a Raffle Ticket is collected by COF, Payment Processor and System Provider solely for the purposes of administering the Raffle and as otherwise set out herein or on the Website and on the respective Payment Processor and System Provider websites. Information collected by COF shall not be used by COF for any other purpose without your express consent. By providing this information, you consent to it being used for the stated purposes. 13. Each Prize claimant acknowledges that COF may, at any time (and from time to time), during the Prize claim process, require certain personal information from the Prize claimant and that the collection of such information (including, in certain circumstances, the Prize claimant's drivers license or Social Insurance Number) is necessary to the proper administration. Any such personal information collected is intended to be used for following principal purposes: to comply with legal and audit requirements, for announcing winners, awarding Prizes, disclosure of insider wins for public scrutiny, and the posting of Prize wins on the Website or other COF platforms for an extended period of time, and for COF internal business purposes. Each Prize claimant further acknowledges that any failure by the Prize claimant to provide the COF with such information may prevent the COF from paying or awarding all or part of the Prize in the manner contemplated.
14. Each Winner, by accepting a Prize, grants COF and the Released Parties full permission, except where legally prohibited, to use such Winner's name, address (city only), image, voice and/or other likeness, and Prize information for advertising, trade and promotional purposes without further compensation and without notice, review or approval, in all media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide and in perpetuity. Each Winner shall execute all documents that COF may require to be signed in connection with this release.
15. **Raffle Tickets are Not Tax Deductible.** Under current applicable law, amounts paid for chances to participate in raffles, lotteries, or similar programs are not gifts and, therefore, the price of the entry does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.
