

# TEAM CANADA 50/50 OFFICIAL RULES OF PLAY QUÉBEC

Updated July 8, 2021

#### TO ENTER

- The Canadian Olympic Foundation 50/50 Raffle ("Raffle") allows fans of Team Canada to participate in a fundraising initiative that supports charitable groups throughout Québec.
- Ticket purchasers will receive a payment receipt and a digital stub to the email used at the time of purchase, listing the numbers associated with the package purchased. Each draw number will be printed on an individual stub. These stubs will be inserted in a barrel in a secure room for the winning ticket draw.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Participation is open only to persons who are physically located in the Province of Québec at the time of purchasing tickets, and who are eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- The following individuals are ineligible to win a prize:
  - a) Any person directly involved in or responsible for selecting the Winning Number;
  - b) Employees, interns and Board of Directors of the Canadian Olympic Foundation:
  - c) Employees, interns and Board of Directors of the Canadian Olympic Committee;
  - d) Members of the same household, (whether or not related) of any of (a-c).

## **DRAW**

- Chances of winning depend on the total number of tickets sold
- Tickets are subject to verification by the Canadian Olympic Foundation. All fraudulent or otherwise ineligible tickets will be automatically be removed from the draw.
- The dates for each draw will be announced on the Canadian Olympic Foundation 5050 Website (TeamCanada5050.ca) at the beginning of and during the ticket sale period.
- At the end of each ticket sales period, the winning ticket stub for that period will be drawn randomly from all eligible ticket stubs sold during that period, by a representative of the Canadian Olympic Foundation, in the presence of 3 physical witnesses (or virtual, if the situation does not allow)
- The winning ticket number will be announced on the 5050 Website. In the event of a discrepancy between the announced (displayed) number and the official winning number, the latter shall be prevail.

## **PRIZE**

- The Winner for each 5050 draw will receive a cash prize (the "5050 Prize") equal to fifty percent (50%) of the final Jackpot amount posted on the 5050 Website for the particular 5050 draw. The 5050 Prize shall not exceed \$5,000 CDN per draw.
- The individual who purchased the winning number will be contacted by telephone or by email using the contact details used at the time of ticket purchase.
- The prize for the 5050 draw must be claimed by the winner, within two (2) days of the applicable draw, by contacting the 50/50 office at the email or telephone number indicated below. If the winner does not claim his/her prize within two business days, a new winning number will be drawn the next business day. The new winner will be contacted by telephone or by email as soon as the new draw is completed.
- Each prize claimant must provide the Canadian Olympic Foundation with all information required by the Canadian Olympic Foundation and/or provincial gaming regulations to demonstrate they are the Winner and claim the Prize, which may include providing government issued identification. In order to receive the Prize, the Prize claimant will also be required to sign a Declaration and Release ("Release") which must be executed and returned to COF no later than five (5) business days after his/her receipt of the Release.
- All Prizes will be sent to the Winners via cheque or electronic funds transfer (as
  determined by COF) within sixty (60) days of Canadian Olympic Foundation confirming the
  prize claimant as the Winner. For security and safety reasons, no cash payments will be
  made to the Winners.

# **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- Raffle Tickets are non-transferable.
- In the event of a dispute over ownership of a ticket, the individual listed at the time of purchase in the application form for the ticket, will be presumed to be the owner of the ticket. Canadian Olympic Foundation shall have no responsibility to any other person who claims any interest or right to receive all or any part of the prize associated with a winning number.
- All personal information, such as name and contact information, required in the
  application form, to enter a draw or purchase a raffle ticket is collected solely for the
  purposes of administering the Raffle and as otherwise set out herein or on the 5050
  Website. Information collected by Canadian Olympic Foundation shall not be used by
  Canadian Olympic Foundation for any other purpose without your express consent. By
  providing this information, you consent to it being used for the stated purposes. Please

- Each prize claimant acknowledges that COF may, at any time (and from time to time), during the prize claim process, require certain personal information from the claimant and that the collection of such information (including, in certain circumstances, the prize claimant's drivers license or Social Insurance Number) is necessary to the proper



administration. Any such personal information collected is intended to be used for following principal purposes: to comply with legal and audit requirements, for announcing winners, awarding prizes, disclosure of insider wins for public scrutiny, and the posting of prize wins on the 5050 Website or other Canadian Olympic Foundation platforms for an extended period of time, and for Canadian Olympic Foundation internal business purposes. Each Prize claimant further acknowledges that any failure by the prize claimant to provide the COF with such information may prevent the COF from paying or awarding all or part of the Prize in the manner contemplated.

- All winners release the Canadian Olympic Foundation, the Canadian Olympic Committee and their respective partners, employees, or any other agents from any responsibility for damages they may incur by accepting or using their prize
- Raffle Tickets are Not Tax Deductible. Under current applicable law, amounts paid for chances to participate in raffles, lotteries, or similar programs are not gifts and, therefore, the price of the entry does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.
- This 50/50 program is subjected to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The decisions rendered by the organizers are final and without appeal in all aspects of the said raffle.

#### PUBLICITY RELEASE

• Each Winner, by accepting a prize, grants Canadian Olympic Foundation and the Canadian Olympic Committee full permission, except where legally prohibited, to use such Winner's name, address (city only), image, voice and/or other likeness, and Prize information for advertising, trade and promotional purposes without further compensation and without notice, review or approval, in all media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide and in perpetuity. Each Winner shall execute all documents that Canadian Olympic Foundation may require to be signed in connection with this release.
