



**TEAM CANADA 50/50
OFFICIAL RULES OF PLAY
YUKON RAFFLE**

Updated July 8, 2021

1. General.

The Canadian Olympic Foundation 50/50 Raffle ("Raffle") allows fans of Team Canada to participate in a fundraising initiative that supports charitable groups throughout the Yukon. The Raffle is operated through an electronic system (the "System") that uses sophisticated hardware and software for the purchase of tickets and for generating, tracking, storing and reporting on numbers associated with purchased tickets and operated and maintained by a third party vendor, Ascend Fundraising Solutions ("System Provider"). By participating in the Raffle, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decisions of the Canadian Olympic Foundation ("COF"), which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to the Raffle. The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, territorial, and local laws and is void where prohibited.

2. Jackpot Prize.

The "Jackpot" for the 5050 Draw is defined as the total proceeds from Raffle tickets sold during the time period for the 5050 Draw ("Raffle Tickets"). The amount of the Jackpot will be tracked by the System, and the amount will be regularly updated and publicly posted online at www.teamcanada5050.ca (the "Website").

3. 5050 Prize and Allocation of Proceeds.

The Winner for the 5050 Draw will receive a cash prize (the "5050 Prize") equal to fifty percent (50%) of the final Jackpot amount for the particular 5050 Draw. The other fifty percent (50%) of the Jackpot will be retained by the COF, and the funds will be used by COF to cover approved expenses and to support Sport Yukon, as approved by the Yukon Professional Licensing and Regulatory Affairs office.

4. Eligibility.

The Raffle is open only to persons who are located in the territory of the Yukon at the time of entry and who are nineteen (19) years of age or older and otherwise meet the conditions specified in these Official Rules. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the following individuals shall be ineligible to win a Prize:

- i. Any person directly involved in or responsible for selecting the Winning Number;
- ii. Employees, interns and Board of Directors of the Canadian Olympic Foundation;
- iii. Employees, interns and Board of Directors of Canadian Olympic Committee;
- iv. Employees of System Provider (Ascend Fundraising Solutions);
- v. Members of the same household, (whether or not related) of any of the above (i – iv).



5. Purchasing Tickets & Draw Date.

A. Draw Date

The draw will take place in accordance with the following period:

Sales Period: July 12 12:01am PT-August 1 9:00 PM PT, 2021

- Sales Cut-Off: August 1, 2021 – 9:00 PM PT
- 50/50 Draw Date: August 8, 2021 – 12:00 PM PT

The draw will take place at the Canadian Olympic Foundation offices at 3000-250 Yonge St., Toronto, ON M5B 2L7. A livestream will be done over Zoom. The link to this stream will be posted on the website.

If the System or Payment Processor experiences any technical difficulties during the Raffle (or any portion thereof) or in the event virus, bugs, unauthorized human intervention, or other causes corrupt administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper operation of the Raffle (or any portion thereof), COF and the territory of Yukon reserve the right to cancel the Raffle (or any portion thereof) and (i) COF will reimburse purchasers for Raffle Tickets or (ii) identify a Winner and award the Prize by way of random drawing from among all non-suspect, eligible entries received up to the time of such cancellation.

B. Purchasing Raffle Tickets

Raffle Tickets may be purchased as follows: ONE (1) Number for \$10.00; THREE (3) Numbers for \$20.00; or TEN (10) Numbers for \$50.00. Unless otherwise stated in this section, there is no limit to the number of Raffle Tickets an individual may purchase, up to the maximum number of tickets available for each package.

Raffle Tickets will be available for purchase as follows:

(A) Online.

- a. Visit www.teamcanada5050.ca where the rules and cause of the 50/50 are explained. The button that says “Click Here to Purchase” will take you to the purchase portal section of the page.
- b. In the purchase portal section, you must:
 - i. Confirm your location and eligibility to purchase; agree to the raffle terms and conditions;
 - ii. Select how many Raffle Tickets you wish to purchase;
 - iii. Enter your contact name, email address and other details requested in application form (“**Application Form**”) NOTE: The individual listed in this section of the Application Form will be presumed to be the rightful owner of the Raffle Ticket(s). Ensure the contact name matches the name on your government issued identification and you may be required to present this to claim a Prize. Acceptable forms of identification include a driver’s license, passport, certificate of Indian Status, and ID card.
 - iv. Enter credit card & billing information as required by Payment Processor
 - v. Confirm purchase.



- c. If the transaction is approved, you will receive a confirmation message with order ID on the web page. An email confirmation will be sent to the email address listed in the Application Form, with order ID, product description and payment information.
 - d. A secondary email (shipping confirmation) will be sent including all of the information in the confirmation e-mail along with proof of purchase of the raffle number(s) purchased. It can take several hours to receive the e-mail shipping confirmation.
 - e. You are required to enter your e-mail address correctly with no errors when purchasing to ensure you receive your proof of purchase and should check your spam and junk mail folders if you have not received your email confirmation by 12:00pm/noon (PT) the day after your Raffle Ticket purchase.
 - f. If you have not received your email confirmation by 12:00pm/noon (PT) the day following the purchase, it is your responsibility to e-mail 5050@olympic.ca the day following the purchase to determine if the purchase was completed and if so, request that your proof of purchase be resent.
 - g. You must e-mail from the same e-mail listed in the Application Form used to purchase the Raffle Ticket(s).
 - h. Any emails sent to 5050@olympic.ca after 12:00pm/noon (PT) the day following the 50/50 Raffle Draw Date to request that their confirmation(s) be resent will not be processed.
 - i. Following the online purchase, paper tickets will be mailed to the purchaser. The confirmation email noted above does not replace the paper tickets being delivered to the purchaser.
 - j. For groups purchasing a Raffle Ticket together, groups must select one individual to handle the purchase; provided, however, that in the event of a dispute over ownership of the Winning Number, the individual listed in the Application Form for the Winning Number, will be presumed to be the Winner. COF shall have no responsibility to any other person who claims any interest or right to receive all or any part of the prize associated with a Winning Number.
- (B) Entrants purchasing Raffle Tickets online must fully complete their purchase by entering the required information and using the procedures specified. All Raffle Ticket purchases are subject to and will be treated in a manner consistent with the Website, the third-party payment processor (“**Payment Processor**”) and System Provider terms of use and privacy policy.
- (C) Individuals are solely responsible for ensuring that they receive the correct ticket denomination and solely responsible for the handling of the purchased ticket after the System has issued the ticket.

6. Personal Information.

All personal information, such as name and contact information, required in the Application Form, to enter a Draw or purchase a Raffle Ticket is collected by COF, Payment Processor and System Provider solely for the purposes of administering the Raffle and as otherwise set out herein or on the Website and on the respective Payment Processor and System Provider websites. Information collected by COF shall not be used by COF for any other purpose without your express consent. By providing this information, you



consent to it being used for the stated purposes. Please see COF's privacy policy at <https://olympic.ca/privacy-policy/>.

Each Prize claimant acknowledges that COF may, at any time (and from time to time), during the Prize claim process, require certain personal information from the Prize claimant and that the collection of such information (including, in certain circumstances, the Prize claimant's drivers license or Social Insurance Number) is necessary to the proper administration. Any such personal information collected is intended to be used for following principal purposes: to comply with legal and audit requirements, for announcing winners, awarding Prizes, disclosure of insider wins for public scrutiny, and the posting of Prize wins on the Website or other COF platforms for an extended period of time, and for COF internal business purposes (e.g. adding those who opt in to the COF e-newsletter). Each Prize claimant further acknowledges that any failure by the Prize claimant to provide the COF with such information may prevent the COF from paying or awarding all or part of the Prize in the manner contemplated. In this event, the Prize will be forfeited by the Winner and will be donated by COF to a charity/non-profit organization if approval of a written request to amend the license is granted by the Yukon Professional Licensing and Regulatory Affairs office.

7. Selection of Winning Number.

Upon the conclusion of the Sales Period, the winning Number (the **"Winning Number"**) will be randomly selected from a barrel from all Numbers sold for the Draw. The Numbers placed in the barrel will correspond with each of the Numbers purchased by the purchasers. The Draw will be made by COF on August 8 at 12:00pm PT via a live stream on Zoom. The link will be posted on the Website. Immediately after the Draw, the Winning Number will be listed on the Website and COF will contact the purchaser of the Winning Number.

8. Prize Claim.

Subject to meeting the requirements set out in this section, the individual listed as the "contact" in the Application Form for the Winning Number for a Draw will be considered the winner of that Draw (the **"Winner"**). Prize claimants who fail to meet all the requirements set out in this section will forfeit the Prize.

The prize must be claimed by the Winner by no later than February 2, 2022, by contacting the 50/50 office at the email or telephone number indicated below, unless otherwise specified by COF thereafter. The COF will also attempt to contact the Winner using the contact information that was provided upon purchase of the ticket(s). Any unclaimed Prizes will be forfeited by the Winner and will be donated by COF to a charity/non-profit organization if approval of a written request to amend the license is granted by the Yukon Professional Licensing and Regulatory Affairs office.

Each Prize claimant must provide COF with all information required by COF and/or Yukon Lottery Licensing Act and Regulations to demonstrate they are the Winner and claim the Prize, which may include providing government issued identification. Acceptable forms of identification include a driver's license, passport, certificate of Indian Status, and ID card. In order to receive the Prize, the Prize claimant will also be required to sign a Declaration and Release (**"Release"**) which must be executed and returned to COF no later than five (5) business days after his/her receipt of the Release. The COF will send the Release by email or mail, using the contact information that was provided upon purchase of the ticket(s).



COF reserves the right to satisfy itself as to the validity of any ticket that is presented as a Winning Number, by means of such authentication and validation tests, requirements and procedures as it may from time to time determine, and to declare that a ticket which does not pass, meet, or fulfill such tests, requirements or procedures is void. A ticket that is presented as a Winning Number will be cross-referenced with the System to ensure accuracy.

All Prizes will be sent to the Winners via cheque within thirty (30) days of COF confirming the prize claimant as the Winner. For security and safety reasons, no cash payments will be made to the Winners.

For groups purchasing a Raffle Ticket together, groups must select one individual to handle the purchase; provided, however, that in the event of a dispute over ownership of the Winning Number, the individual listed in the Application Form for the Winning Number, will be presumed to be the Winner. COF shall have no responsibility to any other person who claims any interest or right to receive all or any part of the prize associated with a Winning Number.

9. Odds.

The odds of winning the Draw depend on the number of Raffle Tickets purchased and total number of tickets sold for the Draw.

10. Transfer of Raffle Tickets or Prize.

Raffle Tickets are non-transferable. The individual listed as the “contact” in the Application Form will be the presumed owner of the Raffle Ticket. Purchasers of Raffle Tickets may not re-sell their Raffle Tickets to other parties and may not give Raffle Tickets away to others. All Raffle Tickets which have been given away or resold in violation of these Official Rules shall be void. All individuals who re-sell, purchase, or receive Raffle Tickets in violation of these Official Rules shall be ineligible to participate in the Raffle or to win a prize.

11. Release of Liability.

By entering into the Raffle, all entrants agree to: (a) be bound by these Official Rules; and (b) release COF and Canadian Olympic Committee, and each of their respective partners, subsidiaries and affiliates, together with the owners, employees, officers, directors, sponsors, volunteers and agents of any of the foregoing (collectively, “Released Parties”) from and against any and all claims, demands, injuries, losses and liabilities whatsoever arising out of or connected in any way to the Raffle. COF will administer the Raffle in good faith and in the best interests of the charitable beneficiaries.

12. Publicity.

Entrants acknowledge that COF and the Released Parties may use Winner's first name, address (city only), and Prize information for advertising, trade and promotional purposes without further compensation and without notice, review or approval, in all media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide and in perpetuity.

13. Raffle Tickets are Not Tax Deductible.

Under current applicable law, amounts paid for chances to participate in raffles, lotteries, or similar programs are not gifts and, therefore, the price of the entry does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.



14. General Conditions.

Entries/Raffle Tickets which are or appear to be tampered with are void. COF shall be the sole judge of the validity and eligibility of all entries. All Raffle Ticket purchases shall be final, and no refunds or replacements will be issued by COF. Released Parties are not responsible for stolen, lost or mutilated Entries/Raffle Tickets; or for lost, interrupted or unavailable network, cable, satellite, server, Internet Service Provider (ISP), wireless network, website, app, or other connections including those through and/or by any website or app, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, cable or wireless transmissions, lines, or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties; any error, omission, interruption, defect or delay in transmission, processing. Released Parties are also not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users, tampering, hacking, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Raffle. Released Parties are not responsible for injury or damage to entrants' or to any other person's computer related to or resulting from participating in the Raffle or downloading materials from or use of the Website. COF shall have the sole right to disqualify any entrant for violation of these Official Rules or any applicable laws relating to the Raffle.

15. Governing Law.

The Raffle and these Official Rules shall be subject to and governed by the laws of the federal government, Yukon, and municipal by-laws that apply to the activities related to running the lottery. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any provision of these Official Rules, or their application to a particular person or circumstance, is invalid or unenforceable to any extent, then the remainder of these Official Rules shall remain enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law. The venue for any cause of action arising out of the Raffle or these Official Rules shall be located in the Yukon.

Caution:

Any attempt to deliberately damage or interfere with the Website, the System, the Payment Processor or any website, email account or social media site associated with the Raffle or undermine the content or legitimate operation of the Raffle may be a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, the COF will disqualify any entrant responsible for the attempt, and the COF and its agents reserve the right to seek damages (including attorneys' fees) and other remedies from any person or persons responsible for the attempt to the fullest extent permitted by law.
