This *Media Handbook*, available on myInfo and the Beijing 2022 Media Extranet, provides essential information for your Games-time media operations. My team will spare no effort to assist in your coverage and operations with all of our Games-time services.

Due to the global Covid-19 pandemic, we will implement the necessary countermeasures to protect the health and safety of all Games participants, including the media. For more information about the Covid-19 countermeasures, please refer to the *Playbook*.

The International Broadcast Centre (IBC) and Main Press Centre (MPC) in Beijing are integrated into the Main Media Centre (MMC), where the press and broadcasters will have easy access to all media services and facilities. In the Zhangjiakou Zone, the Zhangjiakou Mountain Press Centre (ZPC) and the Zhangjiakou Mountain Broadcast Centre

(ZBC) will provide the same quality services as the MMC. Professional Media Operations Teams are also in place in all competition venues, the 2 medals plazas, the 3 Olympic villages and the National Stadium.

The Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022 is around the corner. I hope and believe that Beijing 2022 will bring you joyful and unforgettable memories. Your participation and coverage of the Games will make it truly splendid and meaningful.






The Map of Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022





My 2022 APP

My 2022 APP is a multi-function mobile application designed to provide accredited individuals with information and services related to the Games. Accredited media can communicate with each other via the APP in real time; and access information such as service guides, meteorology, arrivals and departures, competition schedules, event news and medal ranking. It also includes information inquiry and interactive services for health monitoring, food and beverages, accommodation and transport.

The APP is available in Chinese and English on Android, HarmonyOS, and iOS systems.

Please begin to use the Health Monitoring System (HMS) in the APP 14 days before your travel to Beijing, monitor your personal health each day and report the results. You are also required to monitor and report your personal health through the HMS every day during Games time.







Competition Venue Media Centre

Media Workroom

Work stations will be available on a first-come-first-served basis. The Media Workroom is equipped with:

- A help desk providing language services, inquiries, printing and technology support
- A bulletin board providing weather and Media Transport information
- Wi-Fi connection free of charge
- Press/Photo seats equipped with cabled Internet and power sockets (220 V), including a number of accessible seats
- CATV monitors showing live feeds produced by OBS
- Lockers for photographers (one for each photographer)
- Pigeonholes with printed start lists, results and other official Games information

Press Tribune

In general, press tribunes will be available with both tabled and non-tabled seats.

In competition venues, the press tribunes in the ice sports venues include tabled and non-tabled seats, while those in the snow sports venues have non-tabled seats only, including several accessible seats. The services offered in the press tribune mainly include:

- Wi-Fi connection free of charge
- Technology equipment at tabled seats can be booked via the Rate Card Services Centre (the reservations of seats are not guaranteed via Rate Card)
- Tabled seats will be equipped with CATV monitors to provide live feeds, headphone slots (users need to bring their own headphones)

Opening and Closing Ceremony Venue

The Venue Media Centre in the Opening and Closing Ceremony venue will be equipped with press tribunes, media workrooms and media lounges.

There will be no mixed zone or press conference rooms in the Opening and Closing Ceremony venue.

The VMC will open 6 hours before the Opening and Closing Ceremonies, and will be closed 3 hours after the Ceremonies.

Training Venues

At training venues, journalists will be able to access dedicated press areas (including press tribunes and mixed zone) and conduct interviews with athletes during open training sessions.

The opening hours are 1 hour before the start of the official training and 1 hour after the end of the training.

There will be press tribunes and a mixed zone in all training venues.

All training venues will share the VMCs with the adjacent competition venues.

Olympic Villages

The Village VMCs will open from 27 January 2022 to 23 February 2022, with daily operational hours from 09:00 to 21:00. The Village VMCs will be closed on the days of the Opening and Closing Ceremonies, i.e., on 04 February and 20 February 2022.

To get access to the Olympic Villages, media are required to exchange their Olympic Identity and Accreditation Cards (OIACs) for Media Passes. The Village Media Guest Pass is valid for the access to the VMCs and the mixed zones in the Villages.

The media are required to return the Media Passes to get back their OIACs when they leave the Olympic Village.

NOCs can reserve press conference rooms in the Village VMC where professional interpretation services are also provided.

The media lounges in the Olympic Villages will offer refreshments, while there will be no meals or beverages for sale.

Medals Plaza

The operational hours of the Medals Plaza VMC are from 2 hours before the ceremony to 2 hours after the ceremony.

The Medals Plaza VMC provides a media workroom, a mixed zone and a media lounge.

The Beijing Medals Plaza will share the media workroom with the National Aquatics Centre (Curling).


Map of National Speed Skating Oval






Map of Capital Indoor Stadium






Map of Big Air Shougang


Map of Zhangjiakou Genting Snow Park

Map of National Stadium







Facilities and Services for Photographers

MMC & ZPC Facilities and Services for Photographers

The Main Media Centre and the Zhangjiakou Mountain Press Centre each provides a Photo Help Desk, Photo Lockers and a Photo Services Centre.

Photo Lockers are available for photographers (EP) on a first-come-first-served basis. To apply for lockers, photographers are to fill in the application form at the Photo Help Desk. Lockers can be used for five consecutive days, and applications for extensions can be submitted at the Help Desks.

Equipment rental and simple maintenance and repairs are provided by Canon, Nikon and Sony in the Photo Services Centre.

Each photographer is required to complete and sign the *Photographer's Commitment* in person and receive their photo sleeves after signing the document. The photo sleeves can be collected at the MPC Photo Help Desk only.

VMC Facilities and Services for Photographers

A Photo Help Desk, a Photo Workroom and Photo Lockers are available at each Venue Media Centre, except for the three Olympic Villages. Free power and Internet connection (cabled and wireless) are provided at each photo workstation. The Yanqing National Alpine Skiing Centre and the Zhangjiakou Genting Snow Park provide ski racks for photographers. For operational hours of the Photo Workroom, please refer to Venue Media Centre section in Chapter 4.

Photo Positions

The best possible photo positions are planned at each venue. Except for the on-course photo positions, all photo positions are covered with Wi-Fi and stable 4G/5G Internet. All prime photo positions are equipped with power and data sockets. All data sockets at the photo positions are accessible for the Press Plus service. Photo positions are generally available on a first-come-first-served basis. Some prime positions will be allocated with certain rules and procedures.

Supplementary Accreditation Control Device (SACD)

All photographers are required to collect their Photo Sleeves at the MMC Photo Help Desk before the Games. Please note that the MMC Photo Help Desk is the only place to collect the Photo Sleeves. For any loss or breakage, please report to the MMC Photo Manager, and then a new photo sleeve can be collected at the MMC or ZPC Photo Help Desk.

The OIACs together with the SACDs are the necessary accreditation control devices for accessing the Photo Positions. Photographers must wear their photo sleeve at all times while in the venue. Each photo sleeve has its exclusive number and is non-transferable. For detailed regulations, please refer to the daily Venue Photo Briefings and notices at the Photo Workroom.

Remote Cameras

The use of remote cameras is a fundamental part of sports photography. All installations must be requested in advance and approved by the Venue Operations Team.

Olympic Information Service

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Olympic Information Service

The Olympic Information Service (OIS) is a professional sports reporting service designed to keep the accredited media informed and assist them to cover the Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022.

The OIS is jointly delivered by the IOC, OBS and the Beijing 2022 Press Operations Team.

During Games time, the OIS Team of experienced reporters and editors will produce news articles, features, sport previews/reviews, event previews/reviews, flash quotes and press conference highlights. All press conferences, including the IOC-Beijing 2022 Daily Briefings, will be live streamed on myInfo. The videos will be accessible on demand and for download following the end of each press conference.

The OIS reports are factual, informative, unbiased, timely and independent of all external influence. The OIS will operate with a central editorial desk and experienced venue-based sports reporting teams.

With responsibility for overseeing the delivery of athletes, coaches and officials' biographies from the IOC's data provider, the OIS also produces a wide range of pre-Games reports such as venue descriptions, media information, competition format and rules for each discipline.

myInfo

myInfo is the web-based platform on which OIS content is published along with a large amount of other Games-related information.

myInfo is accessible on personal devices such as computers, tablets and smartphones using the accreditation number. myInfo provides additional personalised features for individual users as well.

Content on myInfo

Video and Audio

Live streamed, on-demand and downloadable videos of all press conferences and the IOC-Beijing 2022 Daily Briefings, as well as audio replay of OBS interviews from the mixed zones.

"Ask OIS" Chat

This function allows live conversations with OIS staff to facilitate the remote interview requests.

Schedules and Results

Competition and non-competition schedules, including press conferences, training schedules and IOC activities. Competition results viewable by sport, date and NOC, including entry lists, start lists, extended start lists (limited to certain sports) and additional sport-specific reports.

News

Flash quotes, press conference highlights, sport/event previews and reviews, news articles, statistics, media communications and IOC news.

Entries

Entries of all disciplines by NOCs.

Biographies

Athlete biographies, coach biographies, referee/officials' biographies, team profiles and NOC profiles.

Medals

Overall medal standings, medallists by day and by sport/event, medals by NOCs, multi-medallists and historical medallists.

Sports

Viewable by sport: schedules, results and news, medal standings and medallists, historical data, competition format and rules, qualification system and venue descriptions.

Records



Schedules of the Opening and Closing Ceremonies, ceremony facts, medal ceremony schedules and news.

Access to myInfo

myInfo users can access Beijing 2022 myInfo through the URL: <https://myinfo.beijing2022.cn/>. Each myInfo account can be logged in on up to three devices (e.g., laptop, tablet, mobile phone) simultaneously.

Create an Account

Upon first access, all myInfo users including accredited media will have to create an account by accessing the Self-Registration Page.

Accredited media can create an account with their accreditation number.

Accredited organisations can purchase additional myInfo login tokens via Rate Card for the use by their non-accredited personnel.

Accredited Press who decide not to travel to Beijing for the Beijing 2022 Games will be granted remote access to myInfo, by using their accreditation number.

During the Games, user tokens can either be requested via email (ratecard@beijing2022.cn), through calls to Technology Call Centre (+86-10-66689999) or at the Rate Card Desks located in the MMC and ZPC.

ENR Accreditation

ENR accreditation holders have access to the MMC/ZPC with the audio/video equipment permitted by the IOC's *News Access Rules* but are not entitled to use the facilities and services provided by Olympic Broadcasting Services (OBS).

At the competition venues, ENRs have access to Zone “4” (press areas) including the press tribunes, press conference rooms and mixed zones, but may not bring in camera equipment, recording devices or other technical equipment.

Olympic Identity and Accreditation Card (OIAC)

Functions of OIAC

The Olympic Identity and Accreditation Card (OIAC) is the official Games document that:

- establishes the identity of its holder
- identifies the function and necessary access requirements of its holder
- acts as an official travel document when accompanied with a passport

Accredited foreign nationals who hold an OIAC, together with a valid passport, may enter and leave the Chinese Mainland multiple times between 04 January 2022 (00:00 GMT+8) and 13 April 2022 (24:00 GMT+8).

OIAC holders must also have a passport which is valid at least until 13 May 2022. The personal information on the passport must be identical with that on OIAC. The PVC/OIAC facilitates entry into the Chinese Mainland only and does not function as a visa waiver for any other country or region.

Prior to validation, the OIAC is referred to as a Pre-Valid Card (PVC). The PVC does not allow access to Games venues. After validation at a Beijing 2022 accreditation facility, the PVC becomes the official OIAC and entitles Games participants to access the venues and services corresponding to the holder's function.

The OIAC does not give access to the Paralympic Games venues or services.

Lost, Stolen or Damaged Accreditation Cards

All lost and stolen Accreditation Cards shall be reported to the nearest accreditation centre or venue accreditation office (VAO).

Participants are required to complete a Lost/Stolen Accreditation Card Form and present an acceptable form of identity document.

The accreditation cards, which become damaged in such a way that the photo and/or the personal information is not legible or that the Access Control System is not able to read the card, must be returned to the nearest Accreditation Centre for replacement.

Please note that only within the service hours of an accreditation centre can a PVC or OIAC be re-issued.



The 24-hour airport arrivals and departures services will start from 21 January 2022 (14 days before the Winter Olympic Opening Ceremony) and end on 23 February 2022 (3 days after the Winter Olympic Closing Ceremony).

Beijing 2022 will set up Arrivals and Departures Desks (AND desk), Transport Desks, and AND shuttle bus stations at the airport to provide arrivals and departures services for media.



Spectrum

All users planning to use radio equipment (cameras with wireless transmission modules, wireless microphones, walkie-talkies, Wi-Fi APs) are required to register and submit frequency applications in the Spectrum Order Portal (SOP, <https://spectrum.beijing2022.cn>) in advance.

After obtaining the Frequency License, users are required to take their radio equipment to the designated locations for testing and tagging by the technical agency designated by Beijing 2022.

Only the radio equipment which has passed the tests and been marked with a Special Tag can be brought into the venues and must be used strictly following the requirements indicated in the *Frequency License*.

In order to avoid delays for entry, please make sure to complete the testing and tagging process before arriving at the venue entrance. The specific time and location for testing and tagging are published on the SOP.

Radio equipment exempt from testing and tagging (specified in Section 4.1 of the *Spectrum Management Plan for the Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games Beijing 2022*), such as mobile phones, laptops, tablets, smart watches and Bluetooth headsets, are not allowed to be used as Wi-Fi hotspots and must not have the Bluetooth function turned on while in the venues.

· Beijing Zone

Beijing is the capital of China, located in northern China with an average elevation of 43 metres. Beijing has a typical temperate monsoon climate. The average air temperature of its city centre is -2°C in February.

· Yanqing Zone

Yanqing is a suburban district in the north-western part of Beijing. The average elevation of the Yanqing District is more than 500 metres. The average air temperature is -16°C in February.

· Zhangjiakou Zone


The City of Zhangjiakou is situated in north-western Hebei Province and covers an area of 37,000 square kilometres. The Zhangjiakou Competition Zone is located in its Chongli District. The average air temperature is -16°C in February.

Currency and Payments

Chinese Yuan (CNY) is used throughout China. Foreign currencies can be exchanged at designated locations in the MMC and ZPC. Credit cards are accepted in all media hotels and most restaurants.

Electricity and Voltage

The standard voltage in the Chinese Mainland is 220 V (and 50 Hz). The sockets usually used are two-phase and three-phase flat sockets.



Measurements

The Metric System is used in the Chinese Mainland. Distance is measured in kilometres, with speed signs in kilometres per hour. Weight is measured in kilogrammes, and gasoline is sold by the litre. Temperatures are measured in Celsius.

Tipping

Tipping is neither required nor expected in China, so what is on the bill at cafés, bars and restaurants is the final price that you are to pay. In some restaurants, the bill includes a fixed percentage service charge.

Participation Certificate

Beijing 2022 will distribute Participation Certificates to all accredited media.

The download procedure is as follows:

Step 1: Access the Participation Certificate System through the Beijing 2022 Official Website (<https://certificate.beijing2022.cn>).

Step 2: Choose “Olympic” as Games code and type in your full name and accreditation number.

Step 3: Click on the “Download File” button and save the file to your own device.

The system is available in English, French and Chinese from 04 February to 30 April 2022.

IOC Reporting Tool for Press Freedom Violations

The Media Complaints Reporting Tool of the International Olympic Committee (IOC) enables journalists and media representatives working on Olympic Games-related coverage to lodge a complaint about a press freedom violation they may have experienced.

This tool is intended solely for accredited journalists and media representatives reporting on the Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022. Each incident report will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis.

Without prior explicit consent, the identity of those making the complaints will not be disclosed to persons beyond those responsible for dealing with the complaints.

If the IOC determines that there are strong grounds for accepting that a violation of press freedom occurred in the context of the Games, it will follow up with the relevant stakeholders concerned, such as internal IOC departments and Beijing 2022.

The IOC recommends that all non-Games-related media complaints be re-directed to the relevant international organisations.
